

Conditions for Teams

1. **QUALIFICATION:** Each team that applies for entry into the OVCA Junior SuperSpiel Qualifier must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Each team will consist of four (4) players of the same gender for either the men's' or women's' qualifying event; and,
 - b. Each team member must not exceed the CCA Junior maximum age limit of 20 years of age as of 30 June 2018 (which means athletes born after June 30, 1997).
 - c. Teams already entered in the BrokerLink-OVCA Junior SuperSpiel or the Southern Ontario Junior SuperSpiel Qualifier are ineligible to enter the OVCA Junior SuperSpiel Qualifier.

2. **TEAM RESIDENCY RULE:** An OVCA Junior or Bantam team is eligible to play in this event if the following residency criteria are met:
 - a. A minimum of two team member's permanent residence is within 80 kilometers of the 'OVCA Territory'; or,
 - b. A minimum of two team members previously resided within 80 kilometers of the 'OVCA Territory', but are temporarily residing outside the territory because of school or work commitments.

 - d. The other two team members may reside anywhere else in the province.
 - e. All four team members must be registered with an OVCA affiliated curling club.

3. **WINNING TEAM COMMITMENTS:** In regards to the BrokerLink-OVCA Junior SuperSpiel, in order for a bonspiel of this magnitude to be a success, there is a requirement for many volunteers. Therefore, we must depend heavily on the families of the competing teams to help the organizing committee. Therefore, the Junior Men's and Junior Women's teams that are successful in qualifying for entry into the Broker-Link-OVCA SuperSpiel from October 26 to 28, 2018, must agree to the following conditions:
 - a. Each team must arrange to have two (2) family members work as a volunteer at the SuperSpiel on Saturday, October 27, 2018. for the duration of the Saturday banquet at the Granite C.C. starting mid-afternoon (3pm) and help prepare and serve the meal and assist in clean up duties (duties are normally over by 8pm); and,
 - b. Each team must deliver at least twenty (20) dessert servings to the Granite C.C. for the banquet on Saturday night.
